Freie Universität Berlin once again places among the top universities in terms of funding for international mobility

According to the latest funding statistics of the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) for 2024, around 11.4 million euros were allocated to scholarships, projects, and programs at Freie Universität Berlin. In the nationwide funding statistics, Freie Universität once again ranks among the top universities behind the technical universities in Munich, Dresden, and Berlin. Compared to 2023, Freie Universität increased the funding it received by almost ten percent. This was mainly due to a significant increase in Erasmus+ funding for individual mobility in Europe and worldwide which has almost doubled since 2021. Nationwide, Freie Universität now ranks third in this funding area.
